



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ADULT GOLFERS

Gaudet Luce Golf Club believes that golf is a game that should be enjoyed by all without fear of abuse, harassment, or discrimination. As such we ask that all members sign up to and adhere to our code of conduct.

As a member of Gaudet Luce Golf Club you have a responsibility to other members, visitors, and staff to behave in a manner in keeping with the code of conduct.

You should:

- Help create an environment free of fear and harassment.
- Demonstrate fair play and apply golfs standards both on and off the course.
- Treat others with respect
- Respect other people and their differences.
- Challenge and report if you observe any forms of discrimination or prejudice.
- Report behavior which seems to fall below expected standards of the club.
- Treat the course and surroundings with respect, repairing or reporting any damage you may find.
- Inform the Golf Shop if you cannot use a tee time that you have booked so that others can make use of it.
- Follow the club rules in terms of competition entry and pull out.
- Accept that these guidelines are for the benefit of all.

You should not participate in abusive, inappropriate, or illegal behavior which include:

- Consuming illegal or performance enhancing drugs at the golf club or whilst representing the golf club.
- Drinking alcohol to excess, especially when driving afterwards at the golf club or whilst representing the golf club.
- Using foul or inappropriate language which may offend others whilst at the golf club or representing the golf club.
- Post comments on social media which may put the club into disrepute.
- Behave in a manner that may affect the good name of the club.
